Itinerary to other locations (to verify intention to work for a particular employer)

Be honest – They will sometimes ask questions simply to see if you are honest – They have certain information they can check at their terminals like:

DMV records – including date you obtained a drivers License

Criminal records – They have access to criminal interface to Canada

All they're concerned w/ is proof of prospective Employment

If you require a waiver, it may be better to apply for it at the port of departure (if there's an INS office there), or at the US Consulate abroad. If you don't and the matter gets handled in LA, they are notoriously slow and failure to handle waiver abroad could cause delay.
